The elders were taught simple breathing exercises, standing exercise, heel walks, toe walks, knee exercises, utkat asana, Ekapathasan, sitting seethalai asanas like thandasan. arthabadmasan. parvadasan, makrasana, shantiasana, kapalapathi pranayamam and shoulder excercises.

Agricultural Activities:

The crops planted during January and February rotted due to severe rain. Raddish we got an yield of 240 kgs and onion only 80 kgs whereas we aimed for 450 kgs. Brinjal crop though suffered, gets rectified and giving yield. Up to March we got approximately 200 kgs harvested. 40 seedlings of Mother plant nursery affected severely, rotten and were replaced.
