

taken care by PIMS hospital. During the stay at hospital most of the doctors came forwarded, to see our residents and gave care of our elderly by providing frites and bride.

4.4 MASS CLEANING

During our monthly elders meeting the elders representatives decided to conduct one day mass cleaning program involving all the elders to get clean our camps and other TEV campus. A perfect man wears the perfect cloth. A perfect place should **beneath** and perfect cleaning. The entire camps were cleaned by our residents itself. They residents were decided to allot separate location /place for each individual 'elderly residing. The same was done and name boards displayed in the particular place, a periodical monitoring was done at the resident's representatives of TEV. Now the entire campuses were neat and clean. Watering to the plant and grass were also look after in the same manner by our residents.

4.5 ACTIVE AGENING



For active ageing the elders village staff have indentified more than five income generation skilled based activities, these actives were identified based on the discussion and experience and

skills available with our elderly. During the past three years the tried various activities but they could not able to continue the business. Now each elder do their interested business since they get price at the time of finished good.

In the same way we the team members were identified various simple games and recreational activities during the evening hours to play. Since the elders should keep encaged in some other actives so that they will not feel that they are ideal. Every evening hour they were gathered and play the identified games along with care givers. There are elders they wish to dance, reading books, and hearing music and watching TV in our TEV. by this way our TEV our elders started producing washing powder phenyl pickle apathies submarines, yellow carry bag. Now there about 20 residents busily engaged in these activities.

4.7 INFIRMARY BECOMS - A FULLFIEDGED EMERGENCY PALLIATIVE CARE HOSPITAL ROOM FOR OUR RESIDENTS.

For this great venture, Mahathma Gandhi Medical College & Hospital,

Manakula vinayaga Hospital, and our District level federation doctors where keep engaged to run this clinic, for any emergency our residents are happy in using this facilities Most of the equipments were in used such as ECG, oxygen m for which we have a separate



schedule for each hospital. On the request a specialty doctors also visiting to our TEV to render their services. The elders maintain infirmary neat and clean

Our senior care givers are occupying infirmary on fulltime basis for any emergency the elders were rescued. The care givers also trained to use the equipments such as ECG, Pulse Monitor, O2 Cylinder, and CBG Machine.

The Sterilize Instrument and Dressing material are also kept ready keep in good condition. Managing elders are maintaining to relieve geriatric, friction and conflict.

4.8 COCOUNT TREE PLANATION SUPPORTED BY WOMEN WELFARE TRUST
