<u>22nd Jan – 24th Jan: Paddy harvest at</u> TEV campus.

The first paddy crop of TEV was harvested from 22nd to 24th of January. The organic paddy which was grown in 60 cents of land gave a yield of 18.5 bags of paddy. Two bags of seeds were kept for next kharif sowing and we got 768 kgs of rice (parboiled), which will suffice for 3 months rice need for TEV kithcen, besides two loads of hay and rice bran for dairy animals.



The active resident elders were engaged in paddy seeding, transplanting, weeding, harvesting,

winnowing and packing activities.

<u>23rd Jan: NLC Medical camp – Specialist Doctors visits TEV.</u>

Surgeon, Ortho and Dermatologist of Neyveli Lignite Corporation Govt. Hospital, Neyveli attended the special medical camp organised at TEV. The patients were given treatment, X-rays were verified and for ortho surgery cases, they referred to NLC Hospital for treatment/ surgery.

<u>24th Jan: TEV elders submit their</u> demand on sanctioning of OAP:

About 5 of the TEV residents were recommended for OAP by DSW and the letter was not honoured yet by sanctioning the amount by the tehsildar. The 5 elders were taken by the Manager-



TEV to meet the Tehsildar (Social Protection) and raised their demands. The district administration accepted the

entire 22 applications and promised to send the concerned Revenue authorities for verification.

<u>24th Jan: PMO – Cuddalore Staff</u> meeting:

Elders' representative council of TEV met on 27th January. Started with the prayers for the deceased elder shri.Murugiah, the following decisions were made during the meeting:

- Re-admitting of the elder's shri.venugopal and Natarajan of Nanamedu.
- Amended Food menu revised (diabetic patients were to be given special care providing wheat based food items).

- Fish will be cooked only on Wednesdays and greens twice weekly.
- To meet the District collector for demanding OAP for the 22 applications submitted.

Rs.50, 000 cash donation (by cheque) received from Smt.Rosaline Lalitha, Chennai, partner of Albert Guest House, Pondicherry paid for TEV resident's welfare. The cash was deposited in HI account and a receipt was given to the donor on 19th January 2009.
